No Phone Entries Accepted

- Separate entry form required for each entrant and show.
- Make copies as needed.
- Circle show you are entering on each entry form.
- Any phone calls for clarification will be made to you collect. (If we cannot reach you, your entry may be scratched...see official rules).
- In order to reduce entry errors, be fair to all exhibitors and have a well-organized show, CORBA will strictly follow the entry deadlines and rules outlined in this catalog.

SHOW RULES

This is an official ARBA show. All rabbits will be judged by the latest ARBA Standard of Perfection. This show is governed by the official ARBA Show Rules as printed and available at <http://www.arba.net>. Submission of entry indicates acceptance of these rules as they currently exist.

1. Anyone wishing to work with any of the judges must secure approval from BOTH the Show Superintendent and the judge PRIOR to the show.
2. Entry fees must accompany entry, and no rabbit will be judged until entries are paid.
3. These are one day carrying cage shows. Leak proof bottoms are required on all carriers.
4. Rabbits must have a LEGIBLE tattoo in the left ear.
5. The Judges' decisions are final. There will be no interference with the Judges or judging.
6. Final interpretation of the rules is vested in the show committee. Problems and questions must first be addressed with the Show Superintendent.
7. Only the Judge, table writers and other table help will be allowed behind the judging tables.
8. Rabbits are entered at the sole risk of the owners and/or exhibitors. While show sponsors are expected to exercise all reasonable care in handling and protection of the exhibits, show sponsors are not liable for accidents, loss, mistakes, or damage that occurs.
9. All rabbits entered in Fur must be entered in a regular class.
10. Any rabbit exhibiting signs of disease will not be judged or allowed to remain in the showroom.
11. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times. Any damages will be the responsibility of the parent of guardian.
12. All rabbits will be judged in the class as entered. Please fill out entry forms carefully, including Breed, Variety, Sex and Ear Number.
13. Substitutions will only be allowed in same breed, sex, variety, and class.
14. Pick up exhibitor list and check entry forms prior to judging. No changes will be allowed at the judging table without the show secretary's permission.
15. Breed Assignment of judges is the responsibility of the Show Committee. Personal requests are not accepted.
