Lane County 4-H supports a dress code of long sleeve shirts and long pants for all showings.

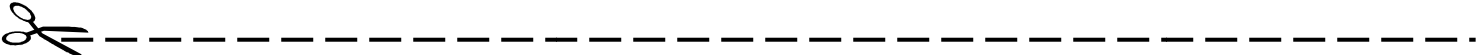
